- ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS**
- If the mare returns in heat in an unusual way: **research other bacterial diseases on the cervix.**
  - If the mare **is changed from one stallion to another** during the course of the breeding season:
    - **New CEM test**
    - **New EVA test**
    - These should be **taken no sooner than 7 days after the mare was last covered by the original stallion.**
    - **Previous results must be submitted.**
  - If the mare is changed from boarding studs, **new tests (all of them) will be required.**
  - Additional swabbing and/or other tests may be required in certain circumstances at the stallion stud manager's discretion.

**\*HIGH RISK REQUIREMENTS :**  
Get two negatives clitoral swabs (sinus and fossa) **AND** a cervical swab 7 days apart, taken during oestrus, after the 1<sup>st</sup> of January. Then follow the "Low Risk" regulations above.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT HARAS DE BOUQUETOT IS FREE TO REFUSE A MARE ON A FOAL-HEAT**
